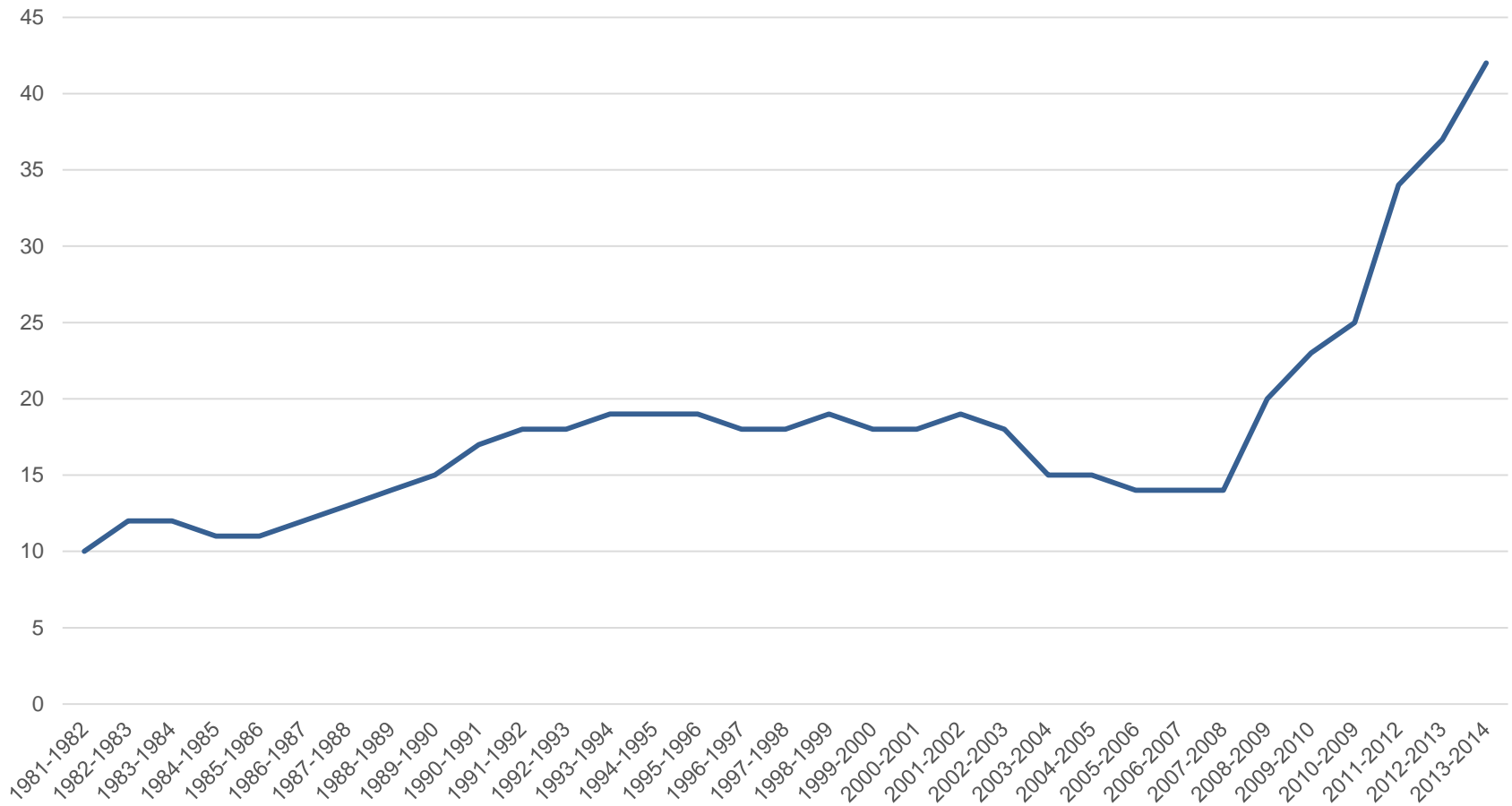


# Example: Large Public University

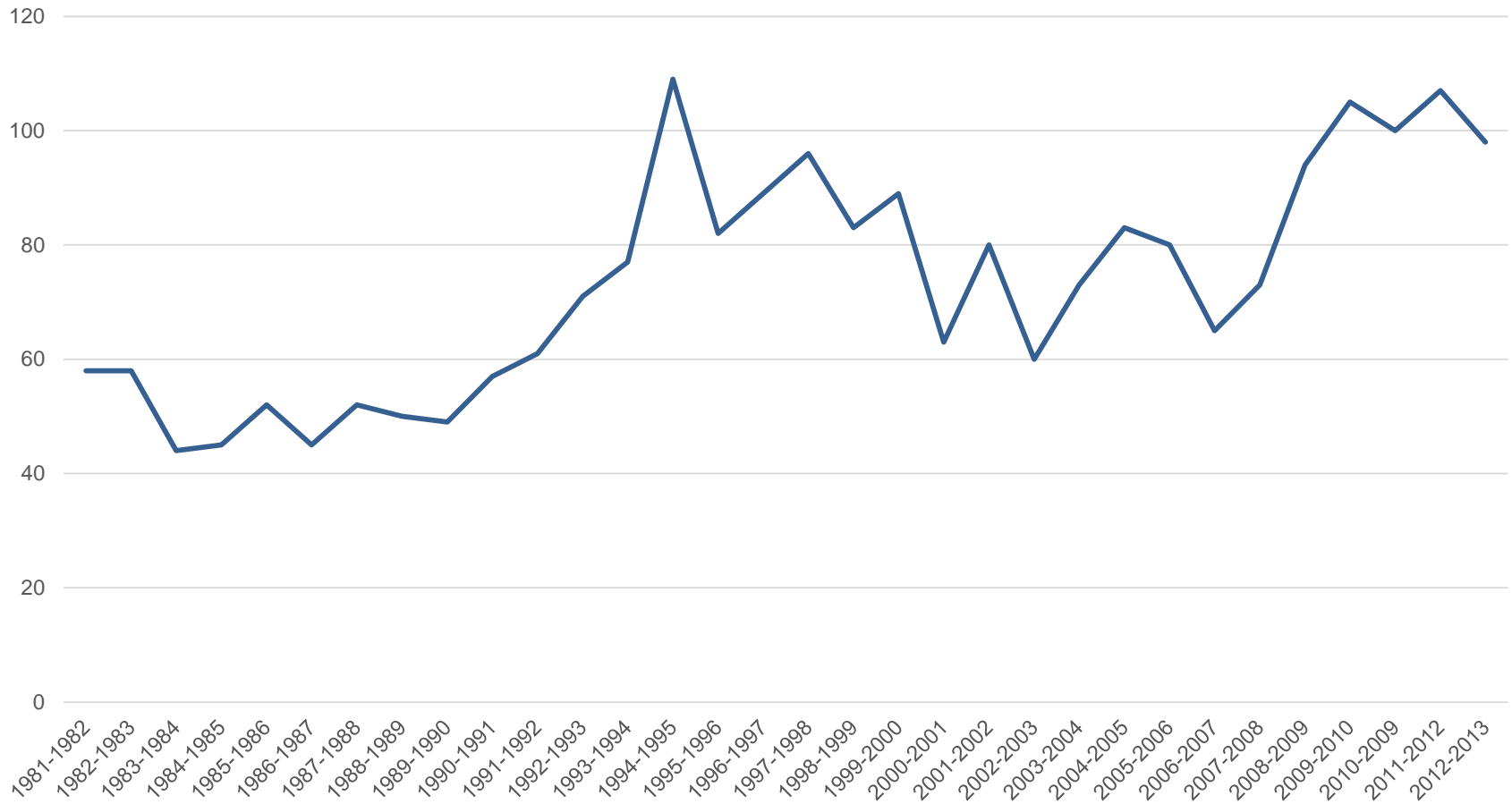
- Our first study abroad program was an exchange (1954)
- All time high exchange program participation: 32 AY students in 1987-88 (Germany)
- Last year - most students on an exchange program: 12 students (2 AY, 5 fall, 5 spring) – UK
- **Growth:** 42 current exchange programs, 22 (52%) have been added in the last 3 years (30 exchanges or **71%** have been added in the last 5 years).



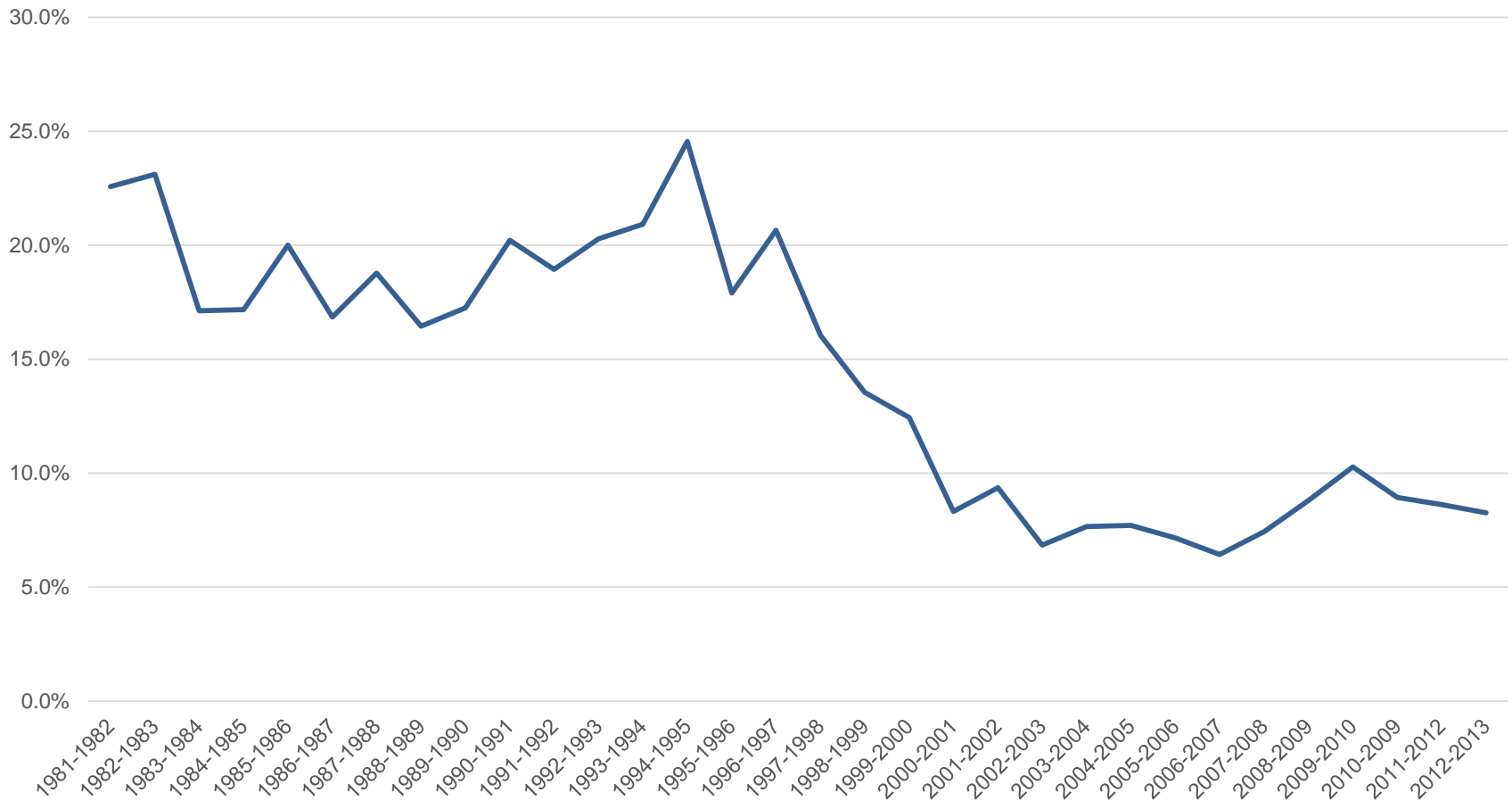
# Number of exchange programs



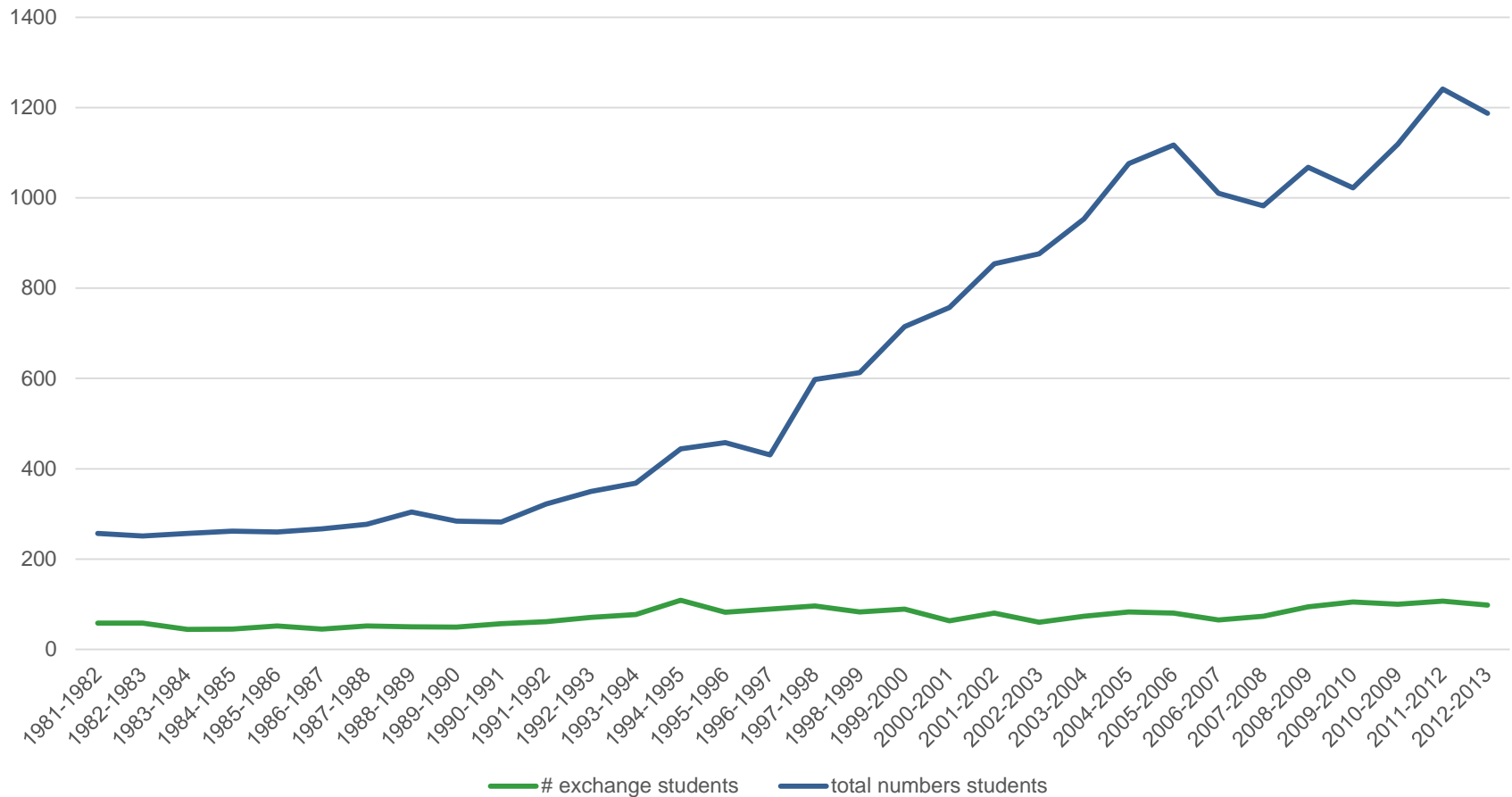
# Number of outgoing exchange students



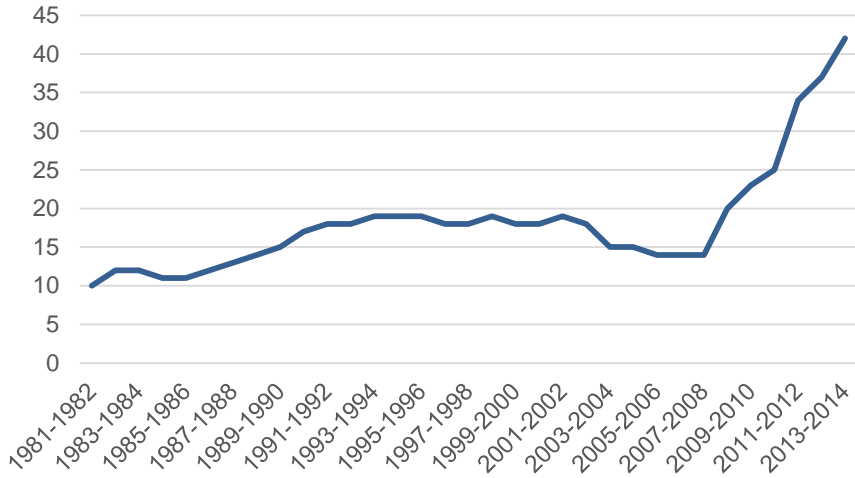
# Percentage of students going on exchanges



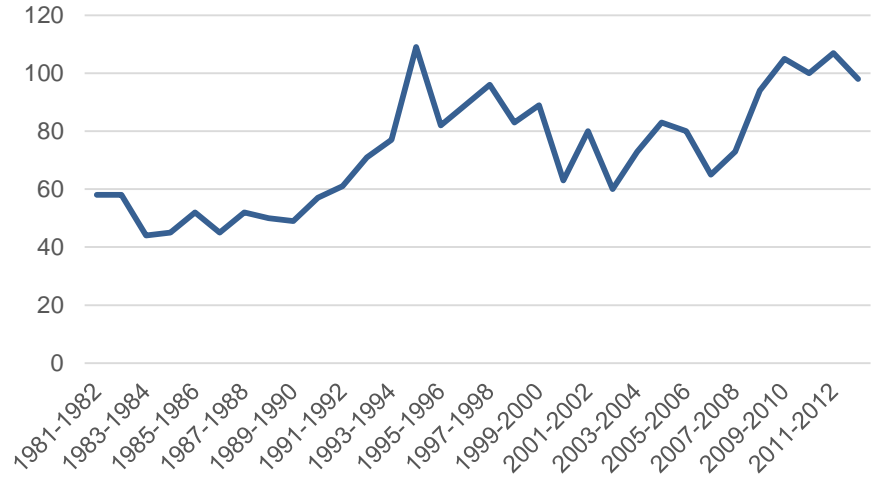
# Exchange students compared to all study abroad students



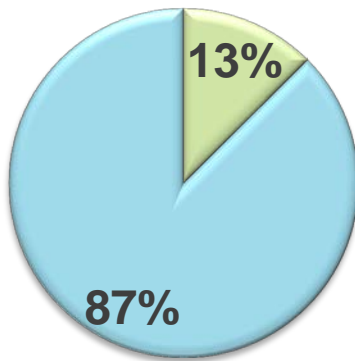
### Number of exchange programs



### Number of outgoing exchange students



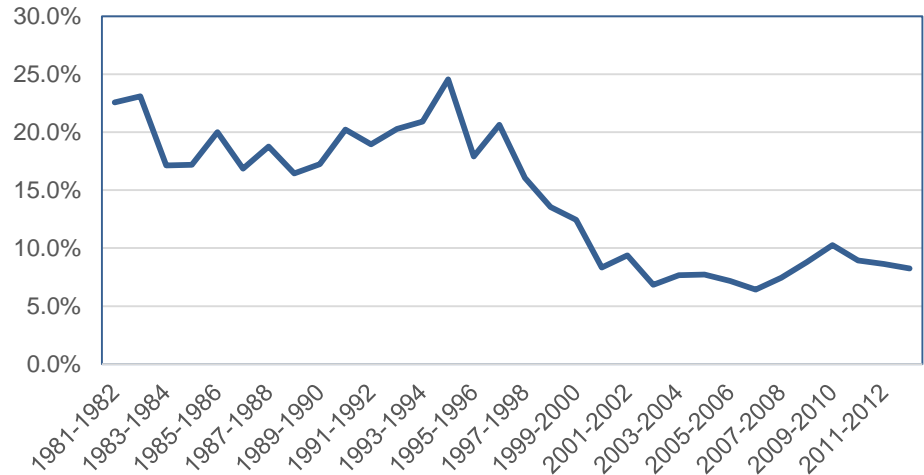
### Exchange vs. Non-Exchange Programs (current)

### Percentage of students going on exchanges



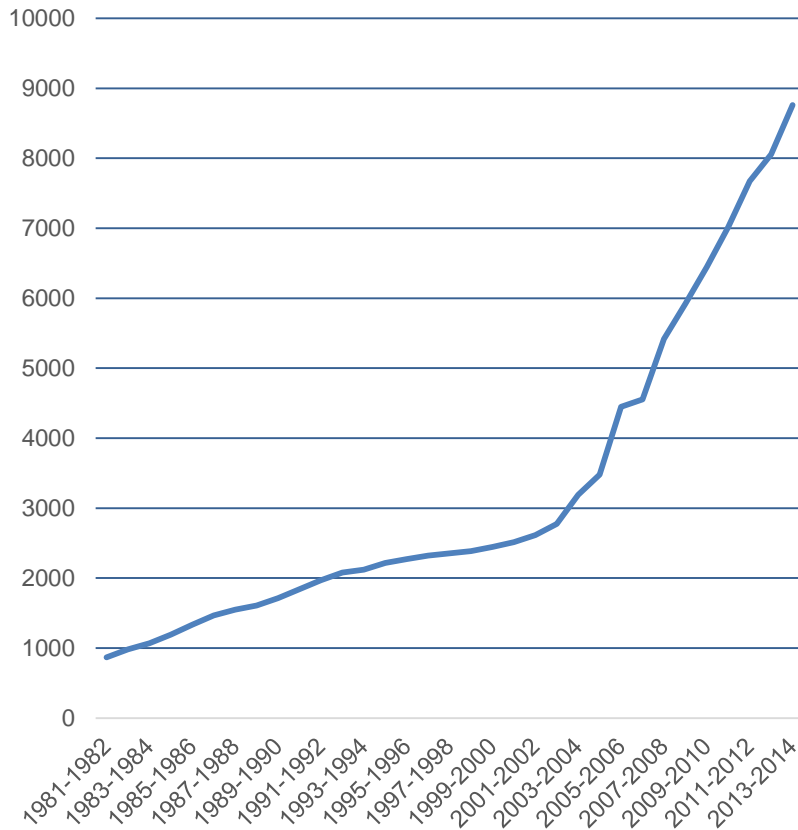
