**Notes:**

ASA = Accommodations and Services Abroad fee, which varies by program.

\*In these cases students are allowed to decide themselves whether they want to stay enrolled in the program or withdraw. If they choose to withdraw, they are liable for the deposit and 50% of the ASA fee, to cover costs already incurred by UC Davis Study abroad on their behalf, such as non-refundable payments for onsite housing, etc. Students must submit notification of their intent to withdraw by email to Study Abroad at [quarterabroad@ucdavis.edu](mailto:quarterabroad@ucdavis.edu) **within 5 business days from when they receive an email from Study Abroad** for the quarter of the status change. If they withdraw after that time period they will be liable for the deposit and 100% of the ASA fee.
