Action Plan

<p>What are your institutional mission, vision, values and goals around internationalization? How are these goals measured?</p>	
<p>Inventory existing curricular or co-curricular opportunities for credentialing and/or opportunities to embed technology (low-hanging fruit)</p>	
<p>Broaden your circle by identifying collaborators with a vested interest within the institution or organization</p>	

<p>Collect evidence and research to professionally justify international education as a credentialed experience</p>	
<p>Create a syllabus or map that illustrates badge or credential-associated learning outcomes and determine assessment process</p>	
<p>Investigate resources needed to credential, including LMS-related resources (learning management systems)</p>
